Probe into illegal cattle slaughter

The Maharashtra State Human Rights Commission (SHRC), presided by Justice KK Tated, has taken serious note of an alleged illegal cattle slaughtering operation in Badlapur. Acting on a complaint, the commission has directed the Thane Commissioner of Police, the Badlapur municipal commissioner, and the chief executive officer of the Thane zilla parishad to form a fact-finding committee and submit a report by November 29.

According to the complaint, over 150 cattle are allegedly reportedly slaughtered daily at illegal facilities in Badlapur, violating the Maharashtra Animal Preservation Act, 1976. The complaint details that cattle are allegedly transported in large vehicles from areas including Thane Rural, Nashik, Pune, and Raigad and are then held near the Sayyed Jallaudin Shah Baba Dargah in Badlapur Village. The alleged illegal slaughter oper-

ations supply beef to various parts of Mumbai, including Deonar, Mankhurd, Agripada, and Crawford Market.

The complainant, who filed the petition after repeated attempts to prompt local police action, claims to have notified authorities in Badlapur and Thane on multiple occasions, starting in April 2024. However, he alleges that the authorities failed to intervene, prompting him to approach the SHRC for relief. The complainant has attached photos of the alleged act, which shows cows and bullocks allegedly tied up in the slaughterhouse.

The complaint names several persons, including Kayes Mansoor Shaikh, Kaif Mansoor Shaikh, Ali Mulla, and Parvez Rauf Kohari, as being involved in the alleged illegal act.

The commission has expressed concern over the allegations and ordered an investigation, emphasising the need to uphold animal protection laws and ensure accountability for illegal activities.

Missing Belapur boy traced to Vrindavan

The 17-year-old boy from Belapur who had gone missing on November 7 has been traced and found safe in Vrindavan, where he had gone on his own. The boy had been taking treatment for attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) for the last month. At around 2.30am on Tuesday, the mother of the boy, Radha Sharma, received a call from the Vrindavan police and spoke to her son. "His father has already left to bring him back home," the mother said.

The boy, a class XII student was a Krishna Bhakt who had been wanting to visit Vrindavan in Mathura. "He had his bag packed and kept but after the fight with his mother, he walked away without taking the bag and stepped out bare foot," police inspector from Anti Human Trafficking Unit (AHTU) said.

Jayesh had shaved his head, leaving a few strands of hair at the back, and told the salon worker it was due to a family death. Later, he told his mother he wanted to join the Hare Rama Hare Krishna mission and left home

HAWKING MENACE | HC directs BMC and state to take action; civic body claimed daily removal of hawkers, says it is the responsibility of cops 'Not a lane or space spared across city'

Directing the BMC and the state government to take strict action against the menace of illegal hawkers, the Bombay High Court said there is not a single lane or space is spared in the city. The court also asked the BMC and the state to stop passing the buck to keep streets free of illegal hawkers.

The BMC claimed that while they regularly remove hawkers, it is the responsibility of the police to keep them from returning. The state, on the other hand, stated that they provide protection whenever requested by the BMC, but it is up to the civic body to monitor illegal hawkers.

The court took suo motu cognisance of the issue while hearing a 2022 petition filed by mobile shop owners in Borivali, who complained that their access was blocked by illegal hawkers.

"People can't enter shops. Despite police being there, they (illegal hawkers) continue to hawk. The entire city is full of hawkers. There is not a single lane that is spared. No area is spared," a bench of Justices Ajey Gadkari and Kamal Khata said on Tuesday, adding: "A child has died." The court was referring to the death of a six-year-old boy in October due to severe burns after a hit oil vessel fell on him in Pydhonie area. The child has gone with his family to have vada pav at a local stall. The incident was brought to the court's notice by Advocate Jashesh Mistry, who was appointed as amicus curiae (friend of court).

Pointing out the recurring menace of illegal hawking, Advocates Sharan Jagtiani and Naushad Engineer, appearing for Bombay Bar Association, said that in Borivali West, the BEST has changed its route as the hawkers spill over on the roads. "We are looking for removal once and for all, there has to be continuous effort. If they continue to come then there is some problem at your end," the bench said. Asking both the state and the BMC to take responsibility, the judges said: "You can't keep blaming each other. You (State) say you are doing your job. They (BMC) say they are doing their job. Citizens come to us." State's advocate Poornima Kantharia said that they provide protection to the BMC officers and they have also

50% decline in birds noted at Uttan camp

In the fourth year of the bird-watching camp held in Uttan near Bhayandar, 50% decline was witnessed in the number of species.

The three-day camp organised between November 6 and 8 by social organisation For Future India under the forest department as part of the Maharashtra bird week, is observed between November 5 and 12 to mark the birthday (5 November) of ornithologist Maruti Chitampalli and the birth anniversary (November 12) of Dr Salim Ali, also known as the 'birdman of India'.

"In the three years between 2021 and 2023, participants observed more than 40 different bird species in two hours. However, this year, less than 20 species were observed apparently due to forest degradation,

tidal inundation, encroachment and human interference," said Harshad Daghe of For Future India.

Apart from officials from the forest department, eminent bird lovers including Amey Bhogte, Suchitra Palaye and Abraham Murugan shared their insights and highlighted the importance of taking conservation measures to stop the alarming decline in the number of species and migratory birds.

Some of the bird species, which were spotted include drongo, common kite, pond heron, purple heron, grey heron, great egret, little egret, intermediate egret, green bee-eater, painted stork, bulbul, myna, black kite, weaver, black-headed ibis, common crow, glossy ibis, Indian grey hornbill and white-bellied sea eagle. Citizens and bird lovers have expressed dissatisfaction over the sharp decline witnessed recently.

MU secures top spot at state cultural event

BABA SIDDIQUE MURDER

Links with Salman and Dawood may be a reason

In the murder case of NCP leader Baba Siddique, the recently arrested shooter has revealed that his instructions were solely to kill Baba, without knowing the exact reason behind it. However, sources indicate that Baba's connections with Salman and links to Dawood Ibrahim might have been motives for the murder.

During interrogation, the arrested shooter, Shiv Kumar Gautam, also disclosed that gangster Anmol Bishnoi had ordered the planning of the murder. Gautam also revealed that he and Anmol Bishnoi first communicated in June through another accused Shubham Lonkar's phone. Since then, he had been in regular contact with Anmol through Lonkar's mobile. During this period, he had several conversations with Anmol over Signal and Snapchat apps about the murder plot while in Pune, discussing various aspects of the plan, with Anmol obtaining every detail. Once the plan was set, accused Shubham Lonkar and Anmol Bishnoi arranged the weapons. Gautam stated he hadn't spoken to Anmol after committed the murder.

The shooter also stated in the interrogation that Anmol Bishnoi had offered him three types of incentives for killing Baba. First, he said that Gautam would become famous after Baba's murder. Second, he would become fully associated with the Lawrence gang. Third, he would receive a large sum of money. Just before the murder, Anmol spoke with Gautam to further convince him, saying that what he was doing was for God and society, encouraging him to proceed without hesitation.

Shirt hidden in pants

According to the crime branch, during Baba's murder, Gautam had hidden an extra shirt inside his pants. After the murder, he walked a little distance and put on the new shirt. Sources say that although the shirt was dishevelled, police did not notice due to the crowd.

MIDC opens up land in Navi Mumbai for residential projects

The Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation (MIDC) has decided to open up land in the Thane-Belapur area for residential complexes. The scheme will see 225 acres of land transferred to the Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) for the development of housing by private developers.

This decision involves the redevelopment of encroached land in the industrial estate, a significant shift in land use policy for the region, which has raised eyebrows as it came days before the implementation of the election code of conduct on October 15. MIDC officials refused to comment on the development.

The land in question – along the Thane-Belapur road and the Sion-Panvel highway, and likely to be worth several thousand crores – has been encroached upon over the years and is currently occupied by slums and unauthorised constructions. Sources said there have been consistent discussions about implementing slum redevelopment schemes in this industrial belt.

The affected areas include Digha, Airoli, Mahape, Pawne, Turbhe, and Shiravane. The land transfer to the NMMC is aimed at facilitating integrated, cluster redevelopment schemes, potentially transforming the area into a new urban hub within Navi Mumbai.

The NMMC had previously proposed the transfer of the encroached MIDC land for the cluster redevelopment scheme, emphasising the need for a feasibility report and the establishment of a special purpose vehicle (SPV). This SPV would be a joint venture between the NMMC and MIDC, with a proposed shareholding of 51-49%. However, the civic body later ditched

this conditional proposal, insisting on a straightforward land transfer.

Commenting on the development, the director of NGO NatConnect Foundation, BN Kumar said, "Before taking up the development or redevelopment of new areas in Navi Mumbai, it is essential to conduct an environmental impact assessment, which includes water, air, open spaces and green cover. But unfortunately, all these aspects are being ignored while increasing the load on the planned city multi-fold."

"We are not opposed to any development but the planners will have to take into account the extra burden due to either cluster development or any other method," Kumar said.

Palliative care supports over 2L patients in 5 yrs

Maharashtra's palliative care clinic programme, implemented for patients with chronic illnesses, has become a crucial support system as 201566 patients have benefited from these palliative clinics in the last five years. Additionally, health department workers have made 101,851 home visits across the state to treat patients suffering from severe diseases.

Many people in the state suffer from debilitating illnesses, making it difficult to care for these patients at home. Recognising this, the state government launched palliative care clinics in 2012 on a pilot basis in Igatpuri and Jawhar, Palghar. However, during the Covid-19 pandemic, realising the need to expand health services, the programme was extended, and clinics were started in 17 districts across the state. According to the health department, patients with chronic illnesses, physical disabilities, and those who face intense pain and other physical, social, emotional, and economic issues benefit

greatly from palliative care clinics.

"Palliative care is looking after the terminally ill patients and their families provided by the health services. The patients are in the last days of their lives or at times even a few hours and the illness that they suffer is incurable by any medical means. Access to palliative care is a human right and is of paramount importance for patients on whom all possible treatments have not given favourable results," said a state health official.

The outpatient (OPD) and inpatient (IPD) count for palliative clinics was 9,776 in 2019-20. Due to the pandemic-induced lockdown, it dropped to 3,947 in 2020-21. It then rose to 38,820 in 2021-22, 44,931 in 2022-23, and 104,087 as of March 2023-24. In these five years, 155,303 patients visited clinics for follow-up.

Psychosocial interventions, generally for issues like substance abuse cessation and relapse prevention, were provided to 143,377 patients. "The number of new patients in both OPD and IPD has gone up every year. The number of psycho-social interventions provided by the centres has also gone-up from 4727 in 2019-2020 to 41689 in 2022-2023," said a senior health official.

Patients in the terminal stages of their lives, where curative therapy is ineffective, primarily benefit from palliative care, which aims to alleviate pain and symptoms. Palliative care is provided to patients with cancer, paralysis, HIV, drug-resistant TB, mentally challenged children, elderly patients with disabilities, and kidney and liver disorders. Eight districts have appointed one trained medical officer, four nurses, and one multi-task worker each. In other districts, officials and staff under the NCD programme have been instructed to examine patients and provide services twice weekly at the district hospitals OPD. In selected talukas, home-based care will also be provided.

मिबंदी शहरातील वाहतूक व्यवस्था सुरळीत होण्याबाबत महापालिका प्रशासन व वाहतूक पोलीस प्रशासन यांच्यात कोणत्याही प्रकारचा समन्वय नसल्याने वाहनचालक, प्रवासी, विद्यार्थी, नोकरदार आणि सर्वसामान्य नागरिकांना शहर आणि परिसरातील वाहतूककोंडीचा फटका बसत आहे. त्याचबरोबर या परिसरातील प्रदूषणात वाढ होत आहे. शहरातील उड्डाणपुलावर नियमित वाहतूक सुरु असताना पुलाखालील वाहतूक सुरळीत करण्यासाठी म्हणून दोन वर्षांपूर्वी महापालिका प्रशासनाने मुख्य रहदारीच्या मार्गावर लाखो रुपये खर्च करून सिग्नल यंत्रणा विविध चौकात उभी केली. मात्र वाहतूक पोलीस नियंत्रण शाखा व महापालिका प्रशासन यांच्यामध्ये ती यंत्रणा



चालविण्यासाठी समन्वय नसल्याने ही यंत्रणा अद्याप बंद अवस्थेत आहे. त्यामुळे लाखो रुपये खर्च करून उभारण्यात आलेली ही सिग्नल यंत्रणा फक्त शोभेचे बाहुले ठरलेली आहे. मुंबई-नाशिक व मुंबई-वाडा या

शहरातून जाणाऱ्या जुना आग्रा रोड मार्गावरून दररोज मोठ्या प्रमाणात वाहतूक होते. सिग्नल यंत्रणा बंद असल्याने वाहतूक पोलीसांवर प्रचंड ताण पडतो आणि वाहतूककोंडी सोडवण्यासाठी धावपळ करावी लागत आहे. भिवंडी

मिबंदी शहरातील मुख्य मार्ग असो की अंतर्गत मार्ग असो सर्व ठिकाणी अरुंद रस्ते आहेत. त्यामुळे हे सिग्नल सुरु केल्यास थांबलेल्या गाडीमागे वाहणाऱ्या रोंग वाढते. त्यामुळे रस्ते रुंद केल्यास डाव्या बाजूच्या वाहणांना नियमित जाण्याचा मार्ग उपलब्ध होऊन वाहतूककोंडी सुटू शकते.

हजार, तर भादवड येथे ७ लाख २५ हजार रुपये खर्च करून मनपाने तीन ठिकाणी सिग्नल यंत्रणा उभी केली आहे. महापालिकेने यासाठी ३० लाख ९४ हजार रुपये खर्च केले. परंतु प्रत्येक ठिकाणची सिग्नल यंत्रणा फक्त उदघाटन दिवशी सुरु झालेली बसविण्यात आली, तर स्व. आनंद दिघे चौक या ठिकाणी १४ लाख ३० हजार, राजीव गांधी चौक येथे ९ लाख ३९

मार्गानुसार अशा प्रकारची सिग्नल यंत्रणा वाढत्या लोकसंख्येमुळे वाढलेली वाहने चार वेळा उभारली आहे. मात्र या यंत्रणा कालांतराने बंद होऊन या यंत्रणेला भंगाराचे स्वरूप येते. याप्रकरणी पालिका प्रशासन व वाहतूक पोलीस शाखा यांच्याकडे अनेकदा

नागरिकांनी तक्रारी केल्या आहेत. मात्र प्रशासकीय पातळीवर प्रत्येकाने आपली जबाबदारी दुसऱ्यावर ढकलल्याने ही समस्या दूर होण्याऐवजी दिवसेंदिवस वाहतूककोंडीचा त्रास वाढत आहे. शहरातील नदीनाका ते अंजुरफाटा आणि कल्याणरोड ते मुंबई-नाशिक बायपास मार्ग या दरम्यान अनेकदा वाहतूककोंडीमध्ये रुग्णवाहिका अडकलेल्या दिसून येतात. शहरातील



असताना शहरात अवजड वाहने मोठ्या संख्येने येत असल्याने होणाऱ्या वाहतूककोंडीत भर पडत आहे. यापूर्वी अवजड वाहनांची वाहतूक परस्पर शहरातील उड्डाणपुलावरून वाहतूकीवर त्याचा परिणाम होत नव्हता. परंतु महानगरपालिकेने अवजड वाहनांना उड्डाणपुलावरून जाण्यासाठी बंदी केल्याने ही सर्व वाहने या उड्डाणपुलाखालून जात असल्याने शहरातील वाहतूकीवर त्याचा परिणाम होत आहे.

वाहनचालक त्रस्त; मोबदल्यासाठी शेतकऱ्यांचा लढा

कर्जत-खोपोली मार्गावरील अर्धवट कामे कधी पूर्ण होणार?

कर्जत ते खोपोली व्हाया पळसदरी मार्गावर वर्षे येथे वाहन चालवताना अतिशय खडतर प्रवास करावा लागत आहे. मोटमोठे खड्डे असलेला हा रस्ता एमएसआरडीसी अंतर्गत तीन वर्षांपूर्वी पूर्ण झाला असला तरी उरवीक ठिकाणी शेतकऱ्यांना मोबदला न मिळाल्याने त्या रस्त्याचे अर्धवट काम पूर्ण करण्याची मागणी वाहनचालक करीत आहेत. एमएसआरडीसीच्या माध्यमातून शाहपूर-मुरबाड-कर्जत-हाल असा कॉन्क्रीटकरणयुक्त राष्ट्रीय महामार्ग क्रमांक ५४८/अ गेल्या तीन



वर्षांपूर्वी काही त्रुटी वगळता पूर्ण झाला. अपवाद म्हणजे पळसदरी मार्गातील वर्ण, पळसदरी, तलवली, हाल, नावडे या ठिकाणी शेतकऱ्यांना जागेचा मोबदला न मिळाल्याने या ठिकाणाचा रस्ता करत आला नाही. त्या ठिकाणचे

काम अर्धवट ठेवून ठेकेदाराचे पसारा आटोपला. मात्र सध्या वर्ण या ठिकाणी खूप मोठे खड्डे असून वेगाने आलेली गाडी कोणतेही दिशादर्शक फलक नसल्याने खड्ड्यात आपटते. त्यामुळे अनेक अपघात या ठिकाणी होत आहेत.

खड्ड्यांतून करावा लागतोय प्रवास

तब्बल १२ गावांतील २५६ शेतकरी बांधित असून अनेक शेतकऱ्यांना मोबदला देण्यात आला नाही. १२ गावांतील शेतकऱ्यांना गेली अनेक वर्षे या महामार्गावर खड्ड्यांतून प्रवास करावा लागत आहे. खोपोली ते कर्जत असा रोज वाहनाने प्रवास करणारे नागरिक या खड्ड्यांमुळे त्रस्त झाले असून ही समस्या लवकर सोडवावी, अशी मागणी सातत्याने केली जात आहे. त्यामुळे एकाच वेळी शेतकरी मोबदला नाही म्हणून आपला लढा कायम ठेवून आहेत, तर वाहनचालक हे या खड्ड्यांमधून रस्त्यामुळे संतप्त आहेत.

शेतकऱ्यांना मोबदला मिळाला नसल्याने शेतकऱ्यांनी रस्त्याचा एक भाग डांबरीकरण, कॉन्क्रीटकरण करून देण्यास विरोध केला आहे.
